Specifications:

- Points will be awarded in regular classes within each section: 10-6-4-2-1-1/2. Classics and show championships will not count for points; a minimum of three entries in each class are required for points to count.
- Categories with both hunter and equitation classes will be considered a horse/rider category and points will accrue to the horse/rider pair. Riders receive the award.
- Gold Coast Series awards will be presented at Gold Coast October.
- Riders must compete in a minimum of two shows prior to Gold Coast October to be in contention for a series award.
- Award winners are encouraged to pick up their awards in person. The show and LEG are not responsible for getting awards to winners who do not attend the show. It is the responsibility of the award winners to pick up awards within 30 days of the final show of the series.
- Any point discrepancies must be reported to the Show Secretary in writing (email) two weeks prior to the final show of the series. No point discrepancies for prior shows will be considered at the final show of the series, Gold Coast October (Oct 18-20).
- Management reserves the right to interpret these rules and make decisions regarding the series awards program.
