



## **Verdugo Hills Series Trainer Incentive Awards**

LEG's Verdugo Hills Series Trainer Incentive Awards reward trainers who regularly participate at Verdugo Hills shows throughout the season, and who have horses and riders that excel in hunters, jumpers and equitation. LEG will award two Verdugo Hills Series Trainer Incentive Awards in 2019, each consisting of a *Getaway* trip to a Marriott vacation resort at Newport Beach, Lake Tahoe, Palm Springs, or Las Vegas.

### **Verdugo Hills Series Trainer Incentive Award**

At each Verdugo Hills show, a trainer's highest scoring hunter, highest scoring jumper, and highest scoring equitation rider will count toward a trainer's Verdugo Hills Incentive points. Only sections that are awarded a show championship will count, and the points will be calculated: 1<sup>st</sup> - 10, 2<sup>nd</sup> - 6, 3<sup>rd</sup> - 4, 4<sup>th</sup> - 2, 5<sup>th</sup> - 1, 6<sup>th</sup> - ½. In the hunter and jumper categories, if a horse is entered in multiple sections, only the section with the greatest number of points will count toward the Verdugo Hills Incentive. Additionally, if an equitation rider competes in multiple sections, only the section with the rider's greatest number of points will count. (Example: a rider could ride in Pony Equitation and 14/under Equitation). A minimum of three entries are required for the section to count for points.

The two trainers with the highest number of points at the end of the Verdugo Hills Series will be awarded a getaway trip of four days and three nights at one of the locations named above. Trainers have one year to use their trips and certain dates may be restricted. Trips must be booked within 90 days of winning the trip in order to guarantee a reservation.

### **General Rules**

Standings will be listed on the LEG website under Programs/Awards, and in the case of a clarification or a dispute, the Verdugo Hills Trainer Incentive Committee will render a decision and their decision will be final.
