Useful Information:

- Opportunity classes are open to entry level riders. See USEF GR 821. Horses are subject to USEF Drugs and Medications rules and testing.
- Horses in the Opportunity and Academy classes are not required to have a Horse Identification Number (HIN) or Recording Number.
- Academy classes are open to horses and riders regularly participating in a lesson program.
- Riders may not cross enter into any classes at the regular (rated) Verdugo Hills Show.
- Horses entered in the Opportunity classes may be ridden by another rider in the regular Verdugo Hills Show.
- Academy horses may only cross enter into the Opportunity classes but must be ridden by a different rider.
- Riders are expected to wear correct show ring attire. All riders must wear an ASTM helmet. Half chaps are permitted with paddock boots. Hunt coats may be waived on hot days, but riders must wear a shirt with a collar and sleeves.
- Horses entered in Opportunity classes must follow the USEF rules regarding tack and equipment for the section referenced (equitation or hunters).
- Horses entered in Academy classes may use the standard tack normally used for that horse's lessons. Martingales are not permitted on the flat, but grazing checks are allowed.
- Academy horses may wear boots, wraps, and/or bell boots, however conservative colors are requested.
- Ribbons will be awarded through fifth and a prize to first. Show championships will be awarded to each section that has at least three riders.
Points will be calculated: 6-4-3-2-1
- All Opportunity Classes will count toward LEGIS League points. Riders must be members in order to earn points.
- Series championships will be awarded at the final show of the season. Series points will be tracked for each section (Points: 6-4-3-2-1). At least three riders must complete the section in order for points to count toward series awards. Series champion and reserve champion will receive a ribbon and prize.

Class Specifications

- Equitation classes will be judged on the standards of the USEF Equitation Division.
- Hunter classes will be judged on the standards of the USEF Hunter Division.
- All classes require cantering except those specifically listed as "Walk/ Trot."
- There will be no oxers in any course.
- Simple changes in Academy classes will not be penalized.
- Classes with at least five juniors and five adults may be split at management's discretion.

*Reg Fee is \$50 with \$35 as the early entry amount.
