## OPPORTUNITY CLASSES

The following classes are designed for entry level riders, and have been developed to create an educational ladder for the beginning competitor. All classes will be judged on control of mount, appropriate pace, steering and effective position. Riders competing in Walk-Trot or Walk-Trot-Canter may not enter any additional over fences classes at the same show.

USEF and USHJA membership is not required to participate in Opportunity classes.

Riders entered only in these classes are exempt from the Federation membership requirements and are not required to pay a Show Pass Fee. *Riders cross entering into any other class at the same show must pay membership or Show Pass fees.*

Horses entered only in these Opportunity classes are exempt from the Federation Fee, including the Drugs and Medication fee and are not required to have a Recording number. Horses are still subject to and must comply with the Drugs and Medication rules and are subject to drug testing.

*There will be no in and outs or oxers in any Opportunity Class.*

**Entries for the Regional Maclay Championship Class close, and must be received by 5:00pm Eastern Time, September 1** at the NHSAA's office. All entries must be submitted electronically with the \$150.00 per class entry fee. Open to Junior Members of the USEF or Equine Canada. Trainers or Coaches (see USEF GR108) must also be members of the NHSAA. Membership year is September 1 through August 31.

All riders wishing to compete in the Finals must qualify for the Regionals based on the state point requirements of their own official rider point state of residence with the USEF.

Riders are judged on seat, hands, guidance and control of horse. Two refusals will eliminate a rider from Regionals Competition.

After completion of the jumping phase, if available, a minimum of ten (10) more riders than one-half the number of riders competing in the Regional are required to show at a walk, trot and canter. At the sole discretion of the judges, additional flat work may be called for, but all groups must be asked to perform the same tests. The Flat performance of those riders selected to show in the flat phase will count 50%. Changing of bit/bridle between phases is allowed. **Use of open numerical scoring is not permitted.**

**HAMEL FOUNDATION NHS 3'3" AREA CHAMPIONSHIP**

The Hamel Foundation NHS 3'3" Medal Classes, Area Championships and Finals are open only to junior members of the USEF or Equine Canada who have not reached their 18th birthday in accordance with GR127 and who have never competed in any of the following National Equitation Finals with fences at 3'6" or higher: ASPCA Maclay Finals, US Medal Finals, USEF Talent Search (East or West), WIHS Equitation Classic Finals, Jump Canada Medal Finals or the North American Equitation Championship. Riders who compete in a Hamel Foundation NHS 3'3" Medal Class may show in the ASPCA Maclay and in any other classes for which they are eligible at the same horse show. Riders may not show in both the Hamel Foundation National Horse Show 3'3" Equitation Championship and the ASPCA Maclay Finals in the same competition year.

**THIS NHS ADULT MEDAL AREA CHAMPIONSHIP**

The THIS NHS Adult Medal, Area Championships and Finals are open only to senior amateur members of the USEF or Equine Canada who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the current competition year in accordance with GR101. Previous winners of the THIS NHS Adult Equitation Championship 18-24 who have reached the age of 25 or over may compete in any THIS NHS Medal classes, Area Championships, as well as the THIS NHS Adult Equitation Championship 25 and Over. Previous winners of the THIS NHS Equitation Championship 25 and Over are ineligible to compete in any THIS NHS Adult Medal, Area Championships, or the Finals. Riders must be current members of the National Horse Show Association ("NHSAA") to compete in all THIS NHS Adult Medal Classes, Area Championships, and Finals. Trainers (or coaches when applicable [see USEF GR108]) of riders competing in all THIS Adult Medal Classes, Area Championships, and Finals must also be members of the NHSAA.

**Area Championships - Entry Fee – \$75**

The Champion, Reserve Champion and Third place finisher from each Area Championship, if not otherwise qualified, will receive invitations to compete in the Hamel Foundation NHS 3'3" Equitation Finals / THIS NHS 3'3" Equitation Finals provided they have points from competing in Hamel/THIS NHS Adult Equitation classes in the same competition year.

To be judged on seat, hands, guidance, and control of the horse. Two refusals will eliminate a rider from Competition. After completion of the jumping phase a minimum of twelve (12) riders, if available, are required to show at a walk, trot, and canter. The flat performance of those riders selected to show in the flat phase shall count 50%. Changing of bit/bridle between phases is permissible.

Conventional tack per USEF EQ 105.5a. Martingales not permitted for the flat phase.

Only riders who have completed the course and competed in the flat phase may receive ribbons. **Use of open numerical scoring is not permitted..** USEF Tests 1-23.
